The award is endowed with EUR 2,500.

The Andreas Zimprich Foundation promotes research and science in the field of brain tumors, with particular emphasis on glioma. The foundation honors an outstanding medical dissertation in the field of neuro-oncology, carried out at the German Cancer Research Center, in one of its clinical cooperation units, at NCT Heidelberg or Dresden, within the DKTK, or in a study center of the Neuro-Oncology Working Group (NOA) of the German Cancer Society, and published in 2019, 2020 or before August 31st, 2021.

- A short CV
- The Dissertation
- At least one publication based on the dissertation
